

Introduction to SDCE

Strathfieldsaye and Districts Community Enterprise is a Not-for-profit organisation dedicated to helping Strathfieldsaye and the surrounding towns become strong, vibrant and healthy communities.

Since 2004, we have distributed approximately \$1.5 million to our community.









The Community Enterprise Model

This assistance is made possible through the support of our partners **Bendigo Bank** and **Bendigo Telco**, who provide us with a sustainable income stream based on business generated by our supporters.

Bendigo Bank and **Bendigo Telco** customers can nominate **Strathfieldsaye & Districts Community Enterprise (SDCE)** as their community beneficiary when they purchase products or services from the Bendigo Bank branch at Strath Hill or Bendigo Telco for their family or business.

SDCE then receive a commission from all tagged accounts and purchases, and return it to the community through grants, sponsorships, contributions to major infrastructure and community events. This is at NO COST to the customer.

It's simple; by keeping the profits of your banking and communications local, YOU can make a real difference to YOUR community.



Who can apply for funding

- ✓ Must be a Not-for-Profit organisation with a valid ABN (that is not a Government ABN)
- ✓ Project focus that provides broad based community benefit
- ✓ Must be based in or servicing Strathfieldsaye and surrounding communities.

What if you don't have an ABN or you have a Government ABN?

Work with a project partner and have them confirm:-

- ✓ That they are supporting the project
- ✓ They will pass the funds on
- ✓ How are they adding value to your project?
- * A template Partner letter of support is available to download from within the application system



What cannot be funded

The following are NOT considered charitable by the Tax Office and/or Law and or do not comply with governance guidelines

- Previously funded entities with projects which have not been acquitted to the satisfaction of the Committee.
- Organisations that have a private benefit for members
- Projects that create a commercial return
- Funding to repay costs already incurred
- Political purposes
- Projects that don't (broadly) benefit the community
- *Government projects or entities
- *Activities that are sporting, social or recreational (only eligible for sponsorship)



What types of projects you can apply for

Applications are invited for up to \$5,000 towards projects & activities which demonstrate broad community benefit for Strathfieldsaye & surrounding communities including East Bendigo, Quarry Hill, Kennington, Strathdale, Spring Gully, Mandurang, Eppalock, Axedale, Redesdale, Longlea, Sedgwick, Sutton Grange and Junortoun.






Application Tips

- ✓ Be clear on the project that you what you want funding for don't use jargon
- ✓ Use a generic email address to register where possible e.g. secretary@
- ✓ Define how the project is going to benefit the community, what success look like?
- ✓ Demonstrate other funding streams
- ✓ Make sure you have acquitted previous funding
- ✓ What's in it for SDCE?



✓ Submit application online with full supporting documents
